Courses typically last 2 days running between 10am-3pm, and include a training pack for each attendee. Courses can be provided either at your offices or at MDCVS.

Charging Structure

As a guide places on training courses start from £70 and a tailored training in your organisation from £400. Consultancy services are worked out at a hourly rate of £40 per hour (£30 for Essex CVS members)
